I'd be very remiss not to thank our ad men over the years, Dick Turner and Dave Callaway, for their help. And certainly a big part of doing our catalogues in the early years was my Aunt Reva and now for the last 25 years (+/-) to Sid Leavitt. Much appreciated!

50 Years of Red Angus Sales

In December 2020 Brylor Ranch will celebrate their 50th anniversary of hosting Red Angus sales in Canada, the first 28 being with their families "Mackenzie Brothers Red Angus Sale" and the last 22 hosted as Brylor Ranch.

Rod Mackenzie Sr. and his wife Mabel settled in Alberta in the early 1900's. They had immigrated from Scotland in 1898 and had spent some time in Oregon before heading north to search for gold in the Klondyke. A baby stopped them in the Mountain View area where they stayed and established a ranching operation, first with Shorthorns, like many cattlemen of the time.

In 1962 grandsons Ted, Rod Jr., Mark, Don and Ken purchased their first Red Angus as Mackenzie Bros., from Beckton Stock Farms in Wyoming. Mark had read about Red Angus and saw an advertisement for some animals for sale. They traveled to Wyoming and returned with two bred heifers, a cow-calf pair and a bull - becoming the first Red Angus herd established in Canada. These cattle were registered in the American Red Angus Society as Red Angus were not allowed in the Canadian Angus herd book at that time. When the Canadian registry started accepting Red cattle in 1968, the herd expanded rapidly, as the brothers purchased additions from many foundation herds in the U.S. In 1979 Mackenzie Bros. received a Red Angus Association of America Pioneer Breeder award and a few years later were recognized by them again as one of the 50 most influential breeders of Red Angus. The herd was known

and advertised as Mackenzie Bros. Red Angus, however each brother owned their own group, and had their own tattoo.

Our story focuses on the Mark Mackenzie (Brylor Ranch) side of the family. Mark was a school teacher in addition to being a rancher, and in 1962 got a job teaching at Halton school at Pincher Creek, where he spent the rest of his career, teaching math and physical education, which he loved. Mark married Edna (Ruks) in 1965 and she worked as a nurse in Pincher Creek for many years, in between raising two sons, Bryan and Lorne. In 1969 Mark and Edna purchased the farm south of Pincher Creek and established Brylor Ranch, named for the two boys. In 1969 Mark also sold the first registered Red Angus bull - Red Mac Larkabelang 15Z to sell in Canada, to Flint and Flint, New Norway, AB, at the Calgary Bull Sale for \$1,700, a good sum at the time. Mark served on the Canadian Angus Association (CAA) and the Canadian Red Angus Promotion Society boards of directors. Mark and Edna traveled to many CAA annual

Bryan learned a strong work ethic from his dad, watching Mark do chores in the dark, in both the morning and the evening, as he taught school and coached many sports. Bryan and Lorne were also encouraged to take whatever career path they chose, but weren't discouraged from ranching. Bryan feels that their goal from year one until now is the same - provide a good lifestyle for the family, and being passionate about what you do, however you also need to still make a living, and your customers need to

make a living. Each generation also does things differently, and Mark and Edna ran just under 50 cows while they both had off farm careers. Bryan has expanded the herd to roughly 300 by managing their grazing land carefully, spraying, fertilizing and cross-fencing to gain the most days on grass for the cows as possible.

The 33 acre pasture of orchard brome and sanfoin alfalfa that we toured in mid-September had yielded 176 bales in late July and the re-growth stood 10-12 inches high. Bryan says "we can't afford more ground, so we need to utilize what we've got" (which is five quarters!).

Uncle Rod, who passed away in 1976, is very much admired by Bryan. Rod took to the 'show road' in 1970 promoting the 'new breed' and was much persecuted for having 'Reds' but he won people over with his personality, positive attitude and great cattle. They were quite successful showing from the P.N.E in Vancouver, BC to the Royal in Toronto, ON including having the Grand Champion and top selling

Bull at the 1971 Calgary Bull Sale, Red Stormalong 3A at \$7,200 to Spearhead Ranch and the many time winning female Red Chevronian 13A, who was said to do as much as any other animal to popularize Red Angus in the early days of the breed in Canada.

Bryan and Sherry are passionate about promotion and marketing and from 1985-2010 Brylor spent a lot of time showing

meetings across the country and enjoyed getting to know many breeders from all provinces. Bryan, along with his wife Sherry and family, Deloy, Erica, Rowan and Isabella now operate the ranch and Lorne manages Varsteel in Lethbridge, while Mark and Edna enjoy retirement in Lethbridge.

their cattle to great success, including back to back Grand Champion Bull in 2005 and 2006 at BOTH Edmonton Farmfair International and Canadian Western Agribition with Red Fine Line Mulberry 26P and his progeny were shown with great success at the 2009 World Angus Forum. Many relationships were developed over that time and the partnership with Nick Van Gaalen on this bull and Nate

Marin, who looked after preparing and showing him, (and many other cattle for Brylor) are ones that are very valued to this day. They were proud to showcase Red Brylor Sequoia 202 as the first bovine to step

foot on the Spruce Meadows grounds in 2004 when the bid to host the World Angus Forum there was put together. Canadian Angus Gold Show awards, for both bulls and females, were won each year from 2001-2009.

In 1997, shortly after they were married, Bryan and Sherry started Mackenzie Sales Management, and their first sale for 77 Stock Farm was a big learning curve, with horrible weather sale day to go along with it. Bryan says he is very glad he went into managing sales, as it opened a lot of doors and was rewarding but

noted that it can be thankless and did also close a few doors to him. Much time was spent on the road visiting farms and ranches across Canada and the U.S. and he learned a lot about what works and what doesn't. He mentions Dick Turner who gave him an opportunity to help select cattle for the Chinook Sale in the early days - Dick said "make a schedule and stick to it". Dennis Ericson, who was also managing sales at the time told Bryan

"Mackenzie, it's all about the people". Bobcat (Brian) Marin, Brant Hurlburt, Jim Leachman, Frank Jenkins, Brent Carey and Brian Bouchard also had a lot of advice for Bryan along the way and he is proud to call them all friends. When asked for a highlight, Bryan says there was nothing like the feeling of having almost 1400 people looking at him

on the 'block' along with Brent Carey as auctioneer and Rob Holowaychuk, OBI, co-manager, during the 2009 World Angus Forum Sale at Spruce Meadows.

In 1998 Bryan and Sherry started Brylor Semen Sales (because they weren't busy enough!). Not many breeders collected bulls on their own then, so the business was quite big for a time. Their All At'd Sales were successful and a lot of

fun, as they hosted them in Alberta, Saskatchewan, Manitoba and Ontario, meeting many great people along the way. We talked a bit about the early days of



putting together sales catalogues and Bryan and Sherry remarked how much appreciation they have for Allan Browary with ShowChampions and Grant and Lauralee Rolston, with GRP Photography for all their excellent work picturing cattle for them over

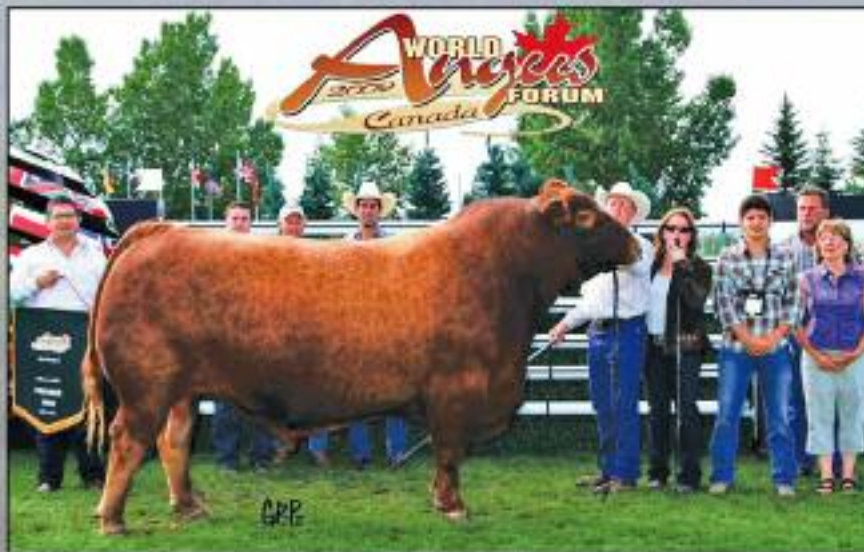


experimenting with breeding some of his good Red Angus females to produce F1 Red Angus/Simmental heifers, as he really believes

that hybrid vigour is what the commercial industry needs to strive for, so we will be watching for that at their Tradition With A Vision Sale this October 24th in Stavely, along with their offering of purebred females. He does note that he does not believe in using cross-bred bulls, and any F1 bull calves are quickly made into steers. Red Angus will always remain a large part of their operation, and Bryan is excited to be a part of assisting Olds College develop their Red Angus herd. Bryan solicited and selected the 10 heifers that were donated to the program this summer, including one that was donated from Brylor Ranch.

If you ever get the chance, take the opportunity to visit Brylor Ranch, we guarantee you will be impressed and well hosted by some great people. We also encourage you to check out their 50th Sale this December 4.

Since introducing this amazing herd bull to our commercial bull customers a few springs back, he continues to impress all who have seen him (our bankers included!) and has proven to be a sound investment at \$77,500. The #1 Red Angus sire in Canada last spring according to the number of calf registrations, his sons have topped bull sales everywhere and a daughter just brought \$11,500 at the Red Roundup. In our Tradition With A Vision Sale on October 24th in Stavely we had eight daughters sell to average \$8000. They were well received to say the least. His semen is now in strong demand once again as a package of 50 just sold to average \$235/straw. With the set of sons in this bull sale and the two year old daughters we already have in production at Brylor Ranch, I believe the future is extremely bright for a herd bull such as Assassin!

The following year, they held their first annual sale featuring bulls and females.

This was the start of a long history of success and dedication which started back in 1962. Year after year, the perseverance they had — not only for their own operation, but for the Angus breed itself — continued. As their operation grew, so did their families. Mark and Edna soon had their own herd with Lorne and Bryan called Brylor Red Angus. In 2000, Mackenzie bothers and Brylor Ranch continued forward, hosting their own separate sales.

Bryan has established himself as one of the top stockman and breeders of Red Angus cattle. “Average” does not even begin to describe the level Bryan and Sherry continue to operate Brylor Ranches. LETTERS FROM SOME INFLUENCES ON THIS BULL SALE OVER THE YEARS....



Our 58 years of Red Angus in Canada and at home...

by Mark & Edna Mackenzie.

It is important to understand why Red Angus became popular and flourished in Canada. Red Angus is because of a recessive red gene in Black Angus. Black is dominant in all warm-blooded species - including humans. A red angus calf was born into a black herd many centuries ago in Scotland. The man decided to exclude the red calf – probably chopped off its head and ate it for dinner. This happened in many herds until several breeders in the USA determined too many reds were showing up. They did what has happened over the centuries: developed a new breed all red in color. Post war, several breeders came together after collecting red angus animals for decades. There were 5 amongst which was a Canadian football player from Saskatchewan, named George Chiga. He ended up in Oklahoma and had a founding herd of Red Angus.

The American Red Angus Association was launched in 1954. They faced a difficult up-hill battle from the established all black American Angus Association. To succeed and gain attention, they decided to develop a program showcasing performance - not done by any other breeds. They concentrated on 4 areas—birth weight, weaning weight, feeding index and adjusted yearling weight, and average daily gain while on feed. Because this was unique, Red Angus was noticed and soon recognized as a leader in animal husbandry. When we started selling Red Angus in Canada, we had to register our animals with the American Red Angus Assoc until 1968 when the Canadian Assoc agreed to open their books and allow us to register our animals with the blacks. Overcoming that hurdle proved invaluable in expanding numbers.

The Canadian Red Angus Promotion Society was founded in 1972 by a group of commercial cattlemen from Alberta and one from Saskatchewan, who decided to develop and promote purebred red angus. And—here we are today- registering nearly 50% of all angus cattle. Successful? Yes!

There is an old adage: “A cow and sow is all a farmer needs to survive”. Now we have government dishing out millions to the Ag. Industry. The Bank of Canada’s top man says, “It’s going to be a slog.”

At the end of September Mark and I took a drive through south eastern B.C. and saw many Red Angus cattle grazing on the open vistas making that now famous “A and W grass fed beef for hamburgers.” It was indeed satisfying to witness the fruits of our endeavors. Without the support and vision of other cattle breeders, their dreams and our efforts would have failed.

When Mark and I married in 1965, Red Angus were virtually unknown in Canada. Mark had seen an advertisement in the August 1960 issue of Cattleman’s magazine by Beckton Stock Farm advertising their sale. Keeping that in mind, but not acting, Mark bought the 1st Charolais/ Hereford cross calf at Cardston, AB, in Oct. The Mackenzie’s were so impressed with the growth/performance of this calf that they decided to crossbreed the next year. He was twice the size of the Shorthorn calves! Dad (Rod,Sr.) said, “I don’t care what you boys do, but make sure the cross is red”. The important lesson is that they acted on that ad in the Cattleman’s. Rod Jr. and Don went to Beckton’s sale in 1962 where they purchased 5 head to start a herd. This became the nucleus of Red Angus in Canada.
